53 unique wineries are scattered through the Texas Hill Country from Austin to Fredericksburg and Lampasas to New Braunfels. Four times a year the Texas Hill Country Wineries hold special wine trails and events together featuring newly released wines, demonstrations, tours, and Hill Country musicians, artists, chefs and entertainers.

Texas Hill Country Wineries are 53 unique wineries scattered through the Texas Hill Country from Austin to Fredericksburg and Lampasas to New Braunfels. The newspaper will be a monthly edition featuring a specific winery and listing the others with a map of their locations. They will be available to customers at wine tasting venues and wineries throughout the hill country area and offered to be sent to customers wanting to subscribe. My audience is the people interested in going to visit the wineries in the area and content is geared for them to better appreciate and discover the towns that they are visiting and all they have to offer. Duchman Family Winery

“Driftwood, just outside Austin, may be famous for its barbecue joint the Salt Lick, but the Hill Country climate also makes it ideal for producing diverse styles of wine. Duchman focuses on wines influenced by unique Italian grape varieties. Their oak-shaded picnic area is a great place for enjoying a bottle while soaking up a balmy Texas afternoon.” – Southern Living

Interview

How was the Duchman Winery established?

The Duchmans are both doctors, still practicing doctors in the Houston area. He’s a cardiologist. She is an optometrist. Originally they were partners with Damien Mandola, who owns the restaurant next door. So the Trattoria Lisina and this was all one property.

That’s why you see Mandola Vineyards when you pull in. Everything was under that name and then, about 6 or 7 years ago, the Duchmans bought this side of the winery off of Damien. He kept the restaurant and they kept the winery part, and took it in their direction. Changed the name and now it’s Duchman Family Winery.

What was their reason for wanting to open up a winery?

They just always had a passion. It’s their second passion, food and wine. So they have just carried that and when they were able to get into this business, as a second business, they took the opportunity.

Has the winery changed since it was established?

The main change was when they separated from Damien, the label changed. Their idea was Italian varietals, not specifically, but mostly Italian wine varietals that are grown in the state of Texas. The main philosophy is 100% Texas grown and 100% Texas produced. That’s the main focus of their philosophy and our winemakers philosophy.

How is the winery run?

Dave is our head winemaker, and he is here all the

time. There is an assistant winemaker and then their helper, so it's really a crew of three people and that's it. We don't bring in outside juice or anything like that. We have grape growing partners in the state, three big ones, which are up in the high planes. The high planes being kind of north Texas or the panhandle. So south of Lubbock there is a town called Brownfield which is home to Bingham Family Vineyard, Oswald Vineyard and Reddy Vineyards. They grow our grapes, what we specifically ask for, and then when those grapes are harvested they come down here and everything is made here. Our other partner locally is Salt Lick. Down the street is Salt Lick BBQ, they grow vines there and we make quite a few wines for Salt Lick, since they do not have a production facility. There is a Salt Lick Cellars that is attached to the restaurant and we make about 5 to 6 wines for them. It's a good partnership.

What types of wine do you specialize in?

Dry Italian varietals are kind of our thing. On the white side, Trebbiano and Vermentino. Reds: Sangiovese, Montepulciano and Aglianico. Those are kind of our core varietals that we use. We do make Tempranillo, which is a Spanish varietal. And we do some Rhône valley French white varietals,

Roussanne and Viognier. So we have experimented with other things, but our staple is dry Italian varietals that are grown here.

What wines are your top sellers?

Vermentino is probably our best-selling white. It's our most popular, most award winning. Then Trebbiano. And then on the red side, Montepulciano and Aglianico kind of go back and forth.

What do those wines pair the best with?

On the white side of things, Trebbiano is kind of like Pinot Grigio. It's really clean and cut and acidic, so like Chardonnay it can pair with poultry dishes. And it goes nice with pasta. Vermentino is a little more versatile. It can go from Cajun food to, I mean I served it at Thanksgiving last year. It's very versatile. It goes nice with fish, seafood, fall vegetables and with a lot of different things. On the red side of things, Montepulciano is kind of a medium body wine, meaning the fruit notes are not too tannic or dry. Aglianico is kind of the ribeye steak wine. It's a little bit more powerful. I like Montepulciano with game, like venison, duck or lamb. Stuff like that goes really nice with it.

Do you need to schedule an appointment for a wine tasting or event?

No, our tasting room is open to the public 7 days a week, so you don't have to make a reservation to come here. You can just come in and enjoy a glass of wine or do a tasting. But we do have private settings too, what we call a PTT or a private tour and tasting, which is a little bit more money per person but you get a private staff member and you get to go through six wines and then you get a tour.

Do you also hold special events?

We do. We'll do things throughout the year. We have a wine club obviously, so we do wine club dinners and pick-up parties where people come to get their wine and we have live music and stuff like that. We do some fun events, like a Catalina Wine Mixer where we play Step Brothers and have a party and food. We have a really talented chef here and he does a really good job. Chef Joseph makes awesome food for all the events.

Are there any new wines that you are in the process of making?

We usually stick with what we do. I would say that the newest thing that we do is Roussanne. We have

made Viognier in the past, but with Roussanne this was our first time to make it. Other than that we do make Tempranillo, which kind of comes in and out of the menu every now and again but that is pretty much it. Those would be maybe not "new" but new right now. But the Roussanne is definitely what people are excited about, what we are excited about. We figured out that it grows really nice here so it has been kind of fun to play with that.

What makes Duchman Winery unique from other wineries in this area?

At one point we were the largest 100% Texas grown, Texas produced winery in the state. It has changed a little bit, there are others who started doing the same, but that is what has always made us unique. We really go through the process to make sure that everything is Texas. That's how the industry seems to be trending and a lot of other people are getting on board with that and really want it to happen, especially the Hill Country Wineries. Everything is grown here. We make everything here. We are not importing from out of state. That's kind of the main focus, I think as an industry, that everyone is looking at. But that's really what separates us. We have a really talented winemaker. He is one of the best in the state and so

that kind of separates us to. And he has been here almost since the very beginning, so we have had that stability for a long time.

Are there any local places that you would recommend to visit in this area?

There are great places in this area. Vista just opened across the street. It is a brewery, but they are doing some really exciting things. They have a farm and their philosophy is a farm-to-table mentality where they are opening a restaurant and everything that goes through the restaurant comes from their farm. They have an 18 hive apiary for bees. Their brewer is very talented. Eventually I think that they want to put 20 tiny homes on the property so that you can stay over. The property itself is very nice and it's kind of that whole farmhouse, brewery, restaurant, farm-to-table type atmosphere that is very cool. Obviously Salt Lick is a staple in this state, which is really popular. Driftwood Estate Winery is right down the street and they do really good things. Fall Creek Vineyards is across from Salt Lick and they also do really good things and have for a long time. If you go up 150 there is Twisted X Brewing. You can go into Dripping Springs and you'll pass the Jester King Brewery, which is an amazing and very popular place.

They are just scattered all over the place. There is some really good stuff and fun things to do.

Are y'all participating in the 2018 Texas Wine Event by Texas Hill Country Wineries?

Yes, October is wine month in Texas so it's a very popular time and it's also wedding season since it's cooling down. So it's also a very popular wedding month. But what the Hill Country will do is a wine trail, where you get a passport. You can go online and purchase that passport in advance and what that gets you, for the participating wineries, is that you can go see four wineries a day and you get a stamp which covers your tasting. And that is for the whole month. It's really great, you get to see all of these different wineries and it essentially pays for itself in two days of using it.

Wine Tasting Descriptions

2016 Vermentino

The quality and flat out deliciousness of Trebbiano has been a fantastic surprise over the last few vintages.

For Vermentino, it's just another day at the office. Expectations are always high for this cornerstone of the Duchman lineup, and the 2016 delivers in a big way. Fresh and racy, this vintage shows hints of white flowers and crushed rock in a sea of citrus beauty. Pretty wines get pretty gold medals, one from the Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition and another from the Texsom International Wine Competition.

#### 2016 Trebbiano

Trebbiano has been the Jan Brady of the Duchman lineup for far too long. It seems like all we ever talk about is "Vermentino, Vermentino, Vermentino!" Well, that is all about to change. Trebbiano has come into its own in our lineup, and in a few short years has gone from "the cool kids' Pinot Grigio" to a full blown Phenomenon. Yep, capital P. Citrus and light tropical fruit notes with balanced, bright acidity equals a super refreshing wine- perfect for summer.... or spring, or fall, or winter, or you know, like a random Tuesday.

#### 2015 Montepulciano

Like Duchman Family Winery, this wine is a little off the beaten path and often mispronounced. That could be why we have a very soft spot for this varietal. Of course, it might be that this wine is a consistent

award winner, gets more and more delicious every year, and has always been one of the most popular bottles in our tasting room. Who knows- could go either way.

#### 2014 Aglianico

Aglianico is not amused by the other wine descriptions on this sheet. Aglianico grows near volcanoes in places with names like Vulture and Taurasi. Aglianico has no idea what "FOMO" means and thinks that "twerk" is a contraction of "get to work." This wine means business. Layers of stewed fruit, structured tannins, hints of baking spice. Enjoy. Or else.

The limit to 4 winery tastings a day with your ticket is a way for THCW to promote responsible drinking during the events. We do hope you can take your time and enjoy each winery more this way, instead of

rushing through tastings and getting to the next stop. This allows for a more intimate experience at each winery, enjoying the wines and the people.

Each ticket will include a Texas Wine Month Tasting Passport to be picked up at your first winery (selected at time of ticket purchase). Each winery you visit will stamp your passport on the day you visit the winery and taste. Each day you can taste and get stamped at four wineries total. Couples tickets will receive 1 booklet but both individuals will receive tastings.

An entire month of enjoying 45 wineries in the beautiful Texas Hill Country, tasting your favorite wines and getting exclusive discounts! This is too good of a deal to pass up, so make sure to get tickets for your entire family and all of your friends!

Q: Are there a limited number of tickets?

A: Yes and they typically sell out by the first weekend of the Trail. We do not hold back any tickets.

Q: Do I have to start at the winery I chose?

A: Yes, you do have to go there first and get your book. You do not have to taste there first but you must get your book first.

Q: Can I change my pickup winery?

A: No, wineries receive the exact amount of Trail Passports as designated by ticket purchaser choice and we cannot change them once delivered. Please be aware of individual winery business hours and days they are open when choosing your pickup winery.

Q: I can't use my ticket, can I get a refund?

A: No, but tickets are transferable so you can give it away or sell it.

Q: What days is my ticket good for?

A: All 31 days of the Trail. October 1st - 31st, 2018.

Q: What wineries are included?

A: 45 of our member wineries. You can find a list of them on the WINERIES page or the MAP page of our website.

Q: I am giving this as a gift, can you change the name on the ticket?

A: The tickets are transferrable so it does not matter that your name is on it. When gifting though, you can choose "Ship To" and put the receivers name in the shipping info and this will put their name on the

ticket. (No, tickets are not shipped)

Q: I can't print my ticket at time of purchase.

A: We also send you a confirmation email with a link to your ticket so you can print at a later date.

Q: I didn't print my ticket and now we are at the winery.

A: You can also show the winery your confirmation email or ticket from your smart phone.

Q: What time does the trail start?

A: The trail starts when individual wineries are open (usually 10-11am) and ends at closing of the wineries (5-6pm). Please check out individual winery hours on the WINERIES page of our site.

Q: Where does the trail start?

A: It starts wherever you would like but you must pickup your Tasting Passport first. Please use the MAP to plan out your trip.

Q: What about transportation?

A: This is a self-guided trail so you will use your own transportation or book with a Tour Company. Please use a Designate Driver.

Q: Are wine glasses included with ticket or at each winery?

A: No glasses are included. Each winery will have wine glasses for you to use while tasting but are not included to take home. Wine glasses are for sale at each winery if you would like to purchase separately.

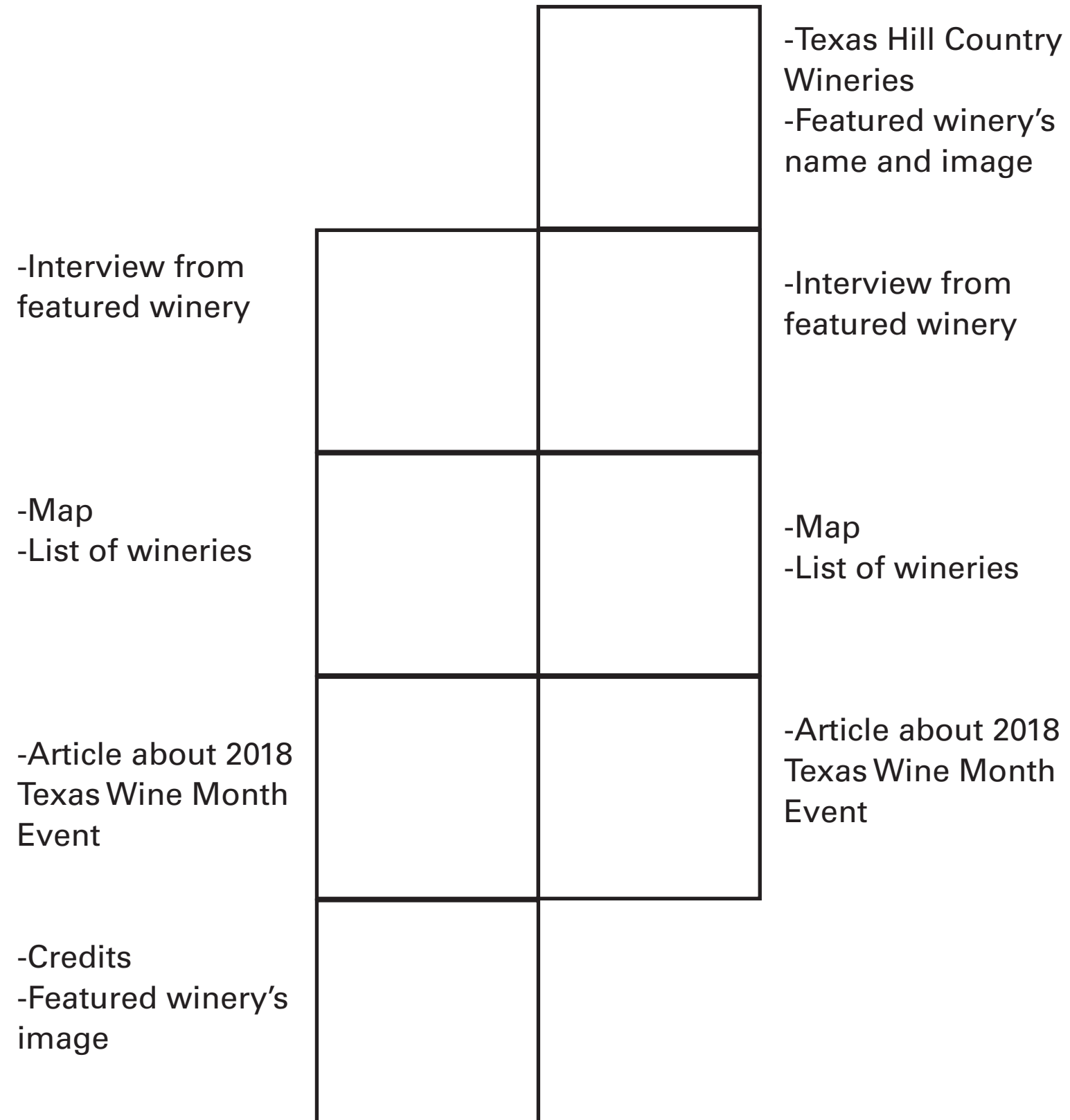
Revised Map

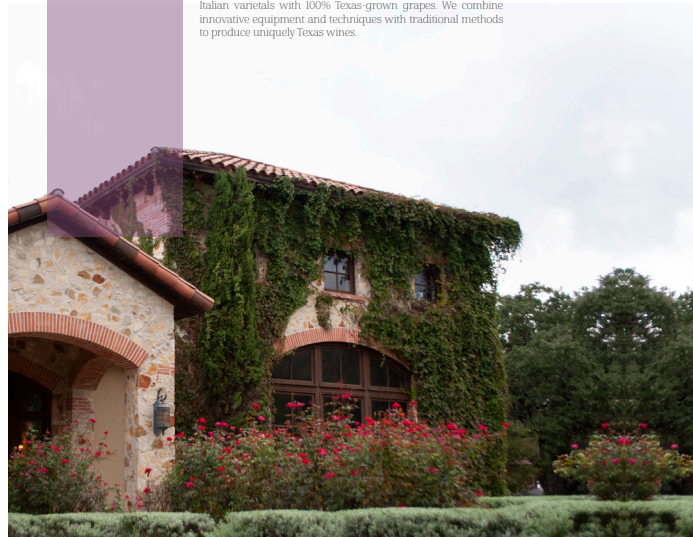

## INTERVIEW

**Q. How was the Duchman Winery established?**  
 A: The Duchmans are both doctors, still practicing doctors in the Houston area. He's a cardiologist. She is an obstetrician. Originally they were partners with Damien Mandolis, who owns the restaurant next door. So the Tattara Llama and this was all one property. That's why you see Mandolis Vineyards when you pull in. Everything was under that name and then, about 6 or 7 years ago, the Duchmans bought this side of the winery off of Damien. He kept the restaurant and they kept the winery part, and took it in their direction. Changed the name and now it's Duchman Family Winery.

**Q. What was their reason for wanting to open up a winery?**  
 A: They just always had a passion. It's their second passion, food and wine. So they have just opted that when they were able to get into this business, as a second business, they took the opportunity.

**Q. Has the winery changed since it was established?**  
 A: The main change was when they separated from Damien, the label changed. Their idea was Italian varietals, not specifically, but mostly Italian wine varietals that are grown in the state of Texas. The main philosophy is 100% Texas grown and 100% Texas produced. That's the main focus of their philosophy and our winemakers philosophy.

**Q. How is the winery run?**  
 A: Dave is our head winemaker, and he is here all the time. There is an assistant winemaker and then their help, so it's really a crew of three people and that's it. We don't bring in outside juice or anything like that. We have grape growing partners in the state, three big ones, which are up in the high plains. The high plains being kind of north Texas or the panhandle. So south of Lubbock there is a town called Bowfield which is home to Bengram Family Vineyard, Crawford Vineyard and Reddy Vineyards. They grow our grapes, what we specifically ask for, and then those grapes are harvested they come down here and everything is made here. Our other partner locally is Salt Lick. Down the street is Salt Lick 880, they grow vines there and we make quite a few wines for Salt Lick, since they do not have a production facility. There is a Salt Lick Cellars that is attached to the restaurant and we make about 5 to 6 wines for them. It's a good partnership.

**Q. What types of wine do you specialize in?**  
 A: Dry Italian varietals are kind of our thing. On the white side, Trebbiano and Vermentino. Reds, Sangiovese, Montepulciano and Aglianico. Those are kind of our core varietals that we use. We do make Tempranillo, which is a Spanish varietal. And we do some Rhône valley French white varietals, Roussanne and Viognier. So we have experimented with other things, but our staple is dry Italian varietals that are grown here.

**Q. What makes Duchman Winery unique from other wineries in this area?**  
 A: At one point we were the largest 100% Texas grown Texas produced winery in the state. It has changed a little bit, there are others who started doing the same, but that is what has always made us unique. We really go through the process to make sure that everything is Texas. That's how the industry seems to be trending and a lot of other people are getting on board with that and really want to happen, especially the Hill Country Wineries. Everything is grown here. We make everything here. We are not importing from out of state. That's kind of the main focus, I think as an industry, that everyone is looking at. But that's really what separates us. We have a really talented winemaker. He is one on the best in the state and so that kind of separates us to. And he has been here almost since the very beginning, so we have had that stability for a long time.

**Q. Are there any local places that you would recommend to visit in this area?**  
 A: There are great places in this area. Vista just opened across the street. It is a brewery, but they are doing some really exciting things. They have a farm and their philosophy is a farm-to-table mentality where they are opening a restaurant and everything that goes through the restaurant comes from their farm. They have an 18 hve apiary for bees. Their brewer is very talented. Eventually I think that they will want to put 20 tiny homes on the property so that you can stay over. The property itself is very nice and it's kind of that whole farmhouse, brewery, restaurant, farm-to-table type atmosphere that is very cool. Obviously Salt Lick is a staple in this state, which is really popular. Driftwood Estate Winery is right down the street and they do really good things. Fall Creek Vineyards is across from Salt Lick and they also do really good things and have a long time. If you go up 150 there is West X Brewing. You can go into Dropping Springs and you'll pass the Jester King Brewery, which is an amazing and very popular place. They are just scattered all over the place. There is some really good stuff and fun things to do.

**Q. Are you participating in the 2018 Texas Wine Event run by Texas Hill Country Wineries?**  
 A: Yes, October is wine month in Texas so it's a very popular time and it's also wedding season since it's cooling down. So it's also a very popular wedding month. But what the Hill Country will do is a wine trail, where you get a passport. You can go online and purchase that passport in advance and what that gets you, for the participating wineries, is that you can go see four wineries a day and you get a stamp which covers your tasting. And that is for the whole month. It's really great, you get to see all of these different wineries and it especially pays for itself in two days of wine it.

**Q. Are there a limited number of tickets?**  
 A: Yes and they typically sell out by the first weekend of the Trail. We do not hold back any tickets.

**Q. Do I have to start at the winery I chose?**  
 A: Yes, you do have to go there first and get your book. You do not have to taste there first but you must get your book first.

**Q. Can I change my pickup winery?**  
 A: No, wineries receive the exact amount of Trail Passports as designated by ticket purchase choice and we cannot change them once delivered. Please be aware of individual winery business hours and days they are open when choosing your pickup winery.

**Q. I can't use my ticket, can I get a refund?**  
 A: No, but tickets are transferrable so you can give it away or sell it.

**Q. What days is my ticket good for?**  
 A: All 31 days of the Trail, October 1st-31st, 2018.

**Q. What wineries are included?**  
 A: All of our member wineries. You can find a list of them on the WINERIES page or the MAP page of our website.

**Q. I am giving this as a gift, can you change the name on the ticket?**  
 A: The tickets are transferrable so it does not matter that your name is on it. When giving though, you can choose "Ship To" and put the receivers name in the shipping info and this will put their name on the ticket. (No, tickets are not shipped)

**Q. I can't print my ticket at time of purchase.**  
 A: We also send you a confirmation email with a link to your ticket so you can print at a later date.

**Q. I didn't print my ticket and now we are at the winery.**  
 A: No, you also show the winery your confirmation email or ticket from your smart phone.

**Q. What time does the trail start?**  
 A: The trail starts when individual wineries are open usually 10-11am and ends at closing of the wineries 5-6pm. Please check out individual winery hours on the Wineries page of our site.

**Q. Where does the trail start?**  
 A: It starts wherever you would like but you must pickup your Tasting Passport first. Please use the map to plan out your trip.

**Q. What about transportation?**  
 A: This is a self-guided trail so you will use your own transportation or book with a Tour Company. Please use a Designated Driver.

**Q. Are wine glasses included with ticket or at each winery?**  
 A: No glasses are included. Each winery will have wine glasses for you to use while tasting but are not included to take home. Wine glasses are for sale at each winery if you would like to purchase separately.
